

1. Philippine Standard Geographic Code (PSGC)

- classifies and codes the Local Government Units (LGU's)
 - region, province, city/municipality and barangay
- periodically update the list of LGU's
- latest update as of March 2013

Regions	-	17
Provinces	-	81
Cities	-	144
Municipalities	- 1	1,490
Barangays	-	42,028





II. Current Activities

- 2. The Local Government Code, RA 7160
 - sets rules on naming of LGU's, public places, streets and public structures
 - National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP)
 - consultation in naming and renaming
 - issued detailed guidelines
- 3. Inventory of Philippine Islands
 - undertaken by NAMRIA
 - number of islands, area, and length of coastlines
 - latest update: Islands with name 2,828
 - Islands without name 4,778
 - Total 7,606







- maximize utilization of geospatial information and geographical names






- 3. Strengthen collaboration with the academe

 - NAMRIA will conduct the following:
 - training courses on Toponymy
 - Field data gathering on geographic names
